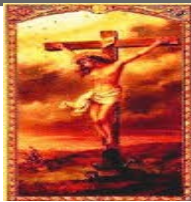

Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday marks the Lord's entry into the Holy City of Jerusalem. Who is this King of Glory? He is the LORD. Although, His Divinity is hidden in His humanity. His omniscience gives clear directions to the disciples about the ass which He will ride into the city. And as the people lay branches before Him, like they would on the agrarian feast of Sukkot giving thanks to God for the bounty for the harvest, they cried out God save us!
