

Dear Friends in Christ,

What does it mean to be a witness of the Resurrection? For the Apostles, they were dumbfounded by the appearance of Christ. And now, He shows them once again in a new way that He is not an apparition—He eats something in front of them. This shows us that the Resurrection of the Body (although a new way of life) is a real and physical resurrection of the flesh.

In the Traditional Lectionary, this Sunday was called "Good Shepherd Sunday" after Jesus calling Himself the Good Shepherd. The image of the Good Shepherd is one of the oldest images in Christianity found on the earliest of Christian catacombs. It pictures the Lord as a Roman man, shaven, with a lamb around His neck. We can picture ourselves in this way—it is not if Jesus will come for us, it is a matter of when. And we can trust in His providence for us knowing that His and by extension our bodily resurrection will be fulfilled when we are faithful to His voice.
