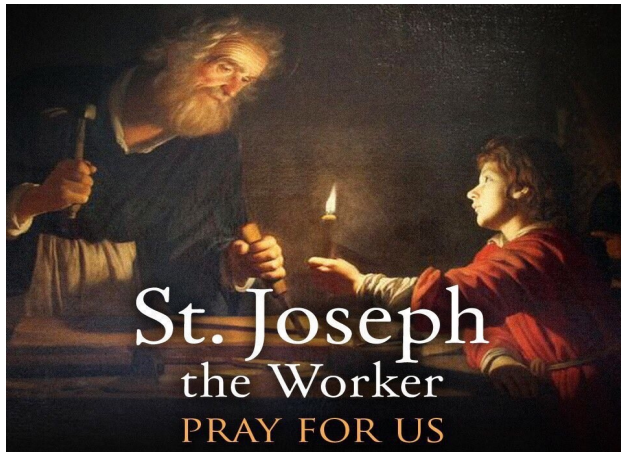
WORLD DAY OF PRAYER, APRIL 30TH ALSO KNOWN AS “GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY”
