

A BIT OF HISTORY

In 1886, Father W.H. Coll, a Chaplin at an Orphanage in St. Joseph, came to Easton to serve the people. With the help of some devoted people, he began the construction of the present church. Early in 1926 Father Mulcahy came he remodeled and enlarged the church under the supervision of Mr. Charles France, an architect and an artist. In 1965, after Vatican Council II, the church was modernized and it was also redecorated.
