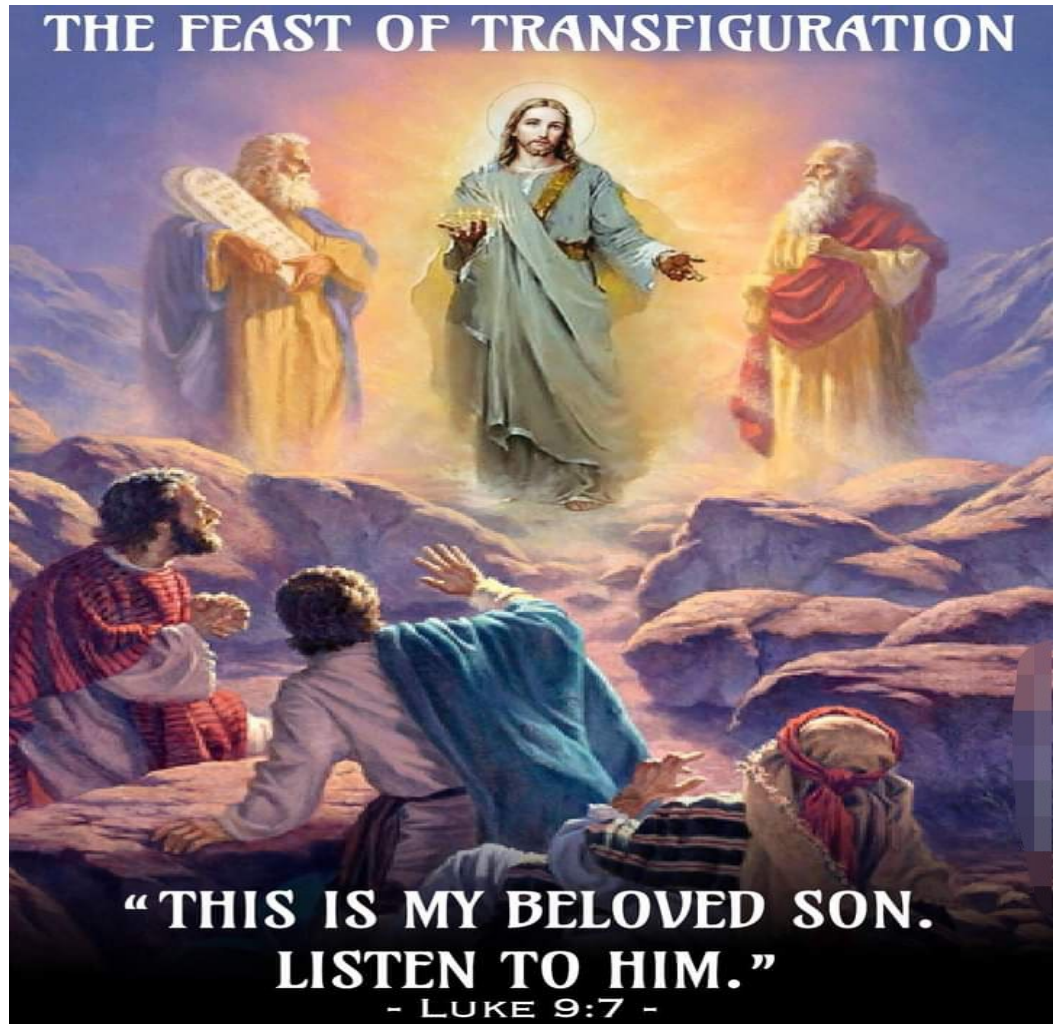

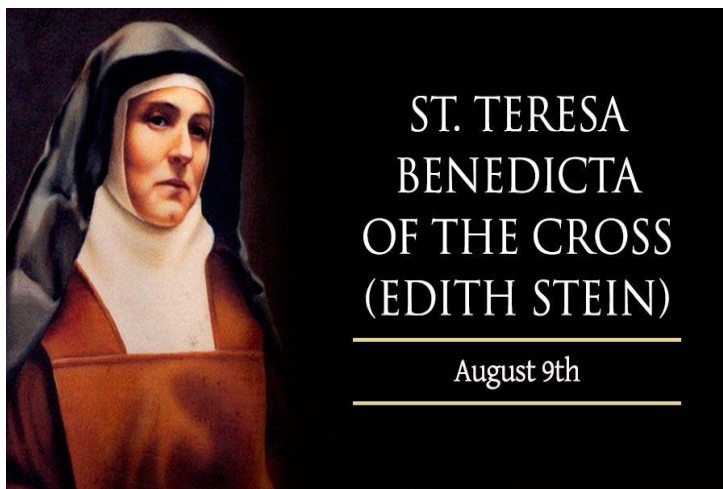

Teresa Benedicta and her sister Rosa, also a Catholic, **died in a gas chamber in Auschwitz on August 9, 1942.** Pope John Paul II beatified Teresa Benedicta of the Cross in 1987 and canonized her 12 years later. The writings of Edith Stein fill 17 volumes, many of which have been translated into English.
