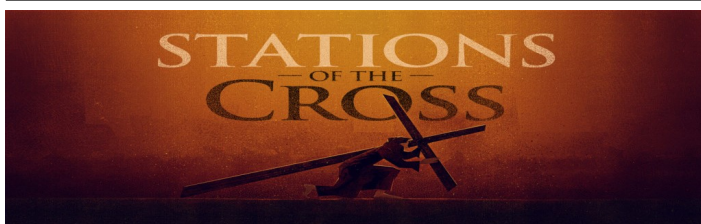

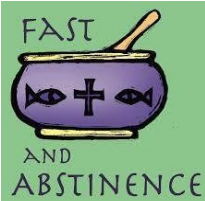

Guidelines for Lenten Fasting and Abstinence. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting. This applies to all Catholics aged 18-59, inclusive. One full meal is permitted each day and two other meals may be taken which, combined, are less than a full meal. Catholics are encouraged to fast on other days. All Fridays, as well as Ash Wednesday, are days of Abstinence. One may not eat meat (beef, pork, fowl, etc.) on these days, though fish (and seafood) is permitted
