Dear Friends of Christ

On this day, we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. It is on this day that yet another part of the mystery of the Epiphany unfolds—the very element that destroyed almost all of humanity in the Flood in Genesis is now made into a means of reconciliation with the Father. The very element that the Hebrew people feared the most is now turned into an instrument of eternal life. Jesus deigns to be baptized in the Jordan River, the place that traditionally led to the Promise Land. What was before symbolic, now takes on real meaning and a supernatural effect in the actual symbol.
