

#### PRO-LIFE IN THE TIME OF COVID:

Because of travel restrictions to Washington DC, the annual Right to Life March, is coming to us. The USCCB Secretariat of Pro-Life Activities is inviting Catholics across the country to observe a nationwide prayer vigil from Thursday, January28th to Friday, January 29th marking the 48th anniversary of the U. S. Supreme Court's 1973 decision Roe vs. Wade. The Vigil will be live broadcast beginning at 7p.m. Central Time on Jan.28th from the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. Tune in on either the Basilica website or usccb.org. Thursday night includes the National Rosary for Life, Opening Mass with Archbishop Naumann, Holy Hour for Life and a Live stream of Holy hours throughout the night.
