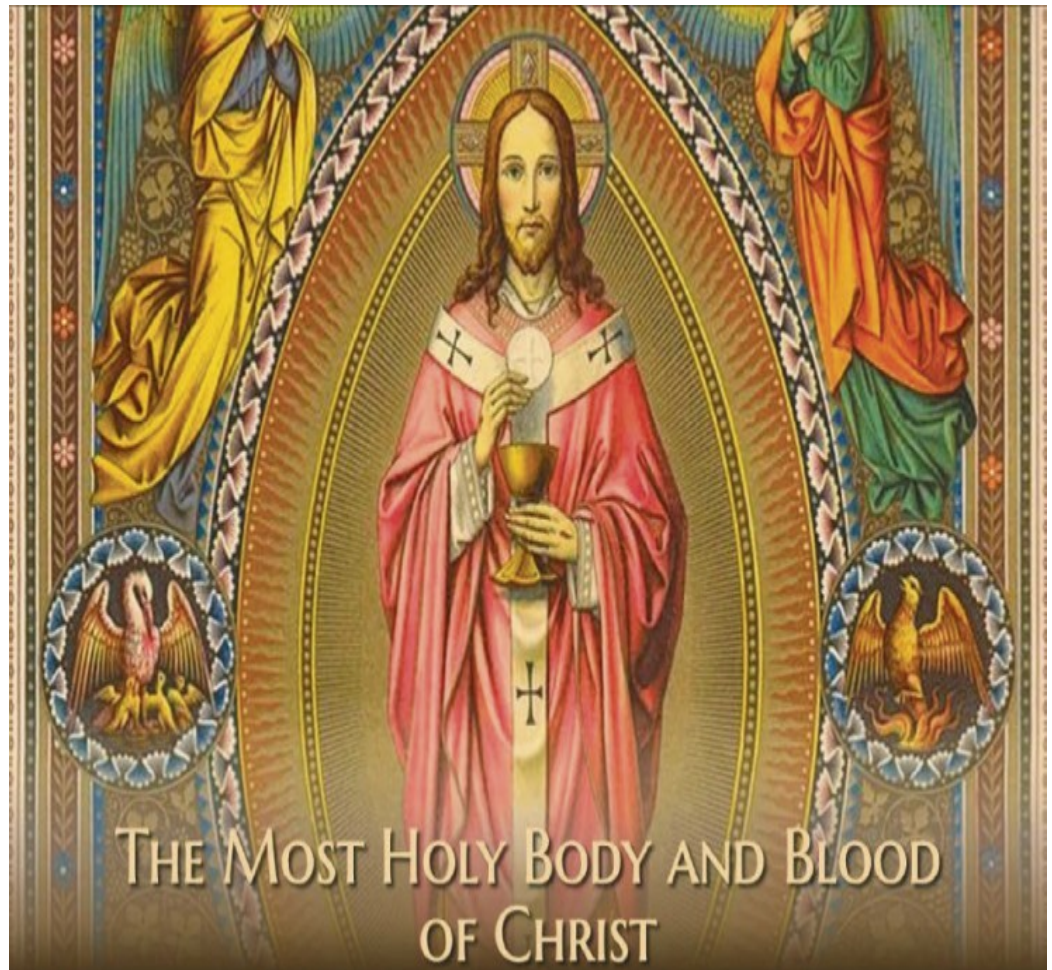

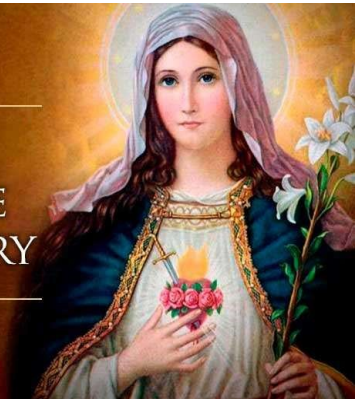

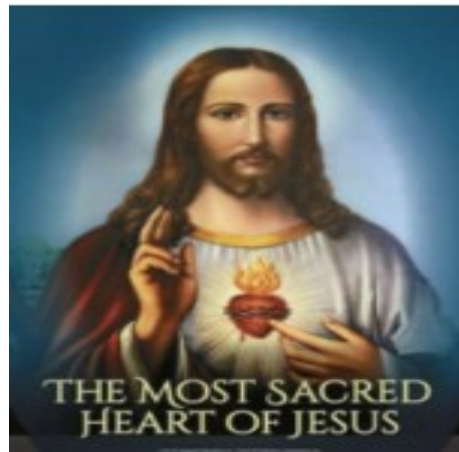
ATTENTION MEN OF OUR CHURCH

THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY



The Sacred Heart of Jesus is the source of Christ's burning love for humanity, and is largely spurned by the indifference of mankind towards Him, the Immaculate Heart of Mary is the source of Our Lady's burning love for God and her desire to bring souls to her Son, and is so often outraged by the offenses of mankind committed against her love.



June is Sacred Heart of Jesus Month

The month of June is known as the month of the Sacred Heart because the solemnity of the Sacred Heart is celebrated this month. A solemnity is the highest-ranking feast in the liturgical calendar, although not a holy day of obligation. This year, the solemnity falls on June 16. The date changes each year because it is celebrated on the Friday after the Corpus Christi octave, or the Friday after the second Sunday after Pentecost.

The feast dates back to 1673 when Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque began to receive visions about the Sacred Heart. Jesus appeared to the French nun and revealed ways to venerate his Sacred Heart and explained the immense love he has for humanity, appearing with his heart visible outside his chest, on fire, and surrounded by a crown of thorns. In 1675, Jesus told Sister Margaret Mary to promote a feast that honored his Sacred Heart and gave her 12 promises made to all who venerate and promote the devotion of the Sacred Heart.
