
Once again you are invited to protect the miracle of life by supporting St. Joseph PRC. During Lent we are going to have our Baby



- 2. After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult to the Ombudsman, at 816 812-2500 if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.
