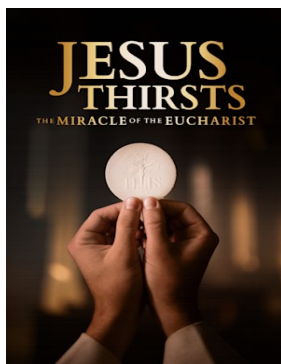
ATTENTION LADIES OF THE CHURCH

NEW ENTRY ARCH TO THE CEMETERY

St Joseph Cemetery Memorial Day, May 26th 2nd Collection

Please give generously for the St Joseph Cemetery here in Easton Missouri. The Cemetery began around 1927 when the Kessler Cemetery north of town could not provide adequate grave spaces for the Catholic Community. The Cemetery has been up kept with great care for nearly 100 years. In the last year we have made substantial improvements to the grounds

1. In the last year we resealed the road in the Cemetery.
2. We had a major tree trimming to all of the trees by Top Notch Tree service from Easton.
3. Michael Fisher has enlisted a company to electronic map all grave sites so a listing of burials can be accessed via the web. (ask Michael if you have questions.)
4. After many months we finally have our nearly 100 year entry arch that says 'St Josephs Cemetery' refabricated. It had to be widened and heightened to allow trucks to enter to resurface the road. Each time we had to take it down and it is very delicate since it is 100 year old cast iron. Local Easton Metal Works completed the project with many local Easton helpers. There new posts are old street light poles and fabrication of the upper support I beam was done in St Joseph by Shamrad Metal Fabricators to support the cast iron sign.

One of our long-term financial goals is to have long term care of our Cemetery after we are all gone. Many cemeteries become abandoned due to no funds left! We have managed our monies responsible and funds have continued to grow for years due to prudent investing. If it is in your means think about leaving a donation in your will or trust to keep the St Joseph's Cemetery looking beautiful for future generations. Speak to a board member if you are interested.
