On this Good Shepherd Sunday, we hear Jesus talking about the qualities of His voice. In the post-resurrection appearances, we intuit the voice of Christ many times and its commanding presence. Whether it is Matthew's version of Christ saying, "Hail," and the women falling at His feet, Mary Magdalene's experience in the garden when she mistakes Him for the gardener until she hears His voice, or even at the Sea of

Tiberius wherein the Apostles are unsure at first if it is the Lord, but know His voice when He calls. Paschaltide is a time where we, too can discern the voice of Christ in our lives. Jesus said to Phillip in chapter 14 of John's Gospel when Philip asked Jesus to show the disciples the Father, that His face shows the Father. Jesus in chapter 10, today, says that He and the Father are one. When we hear the words of the Holy Gospel and the Church teaching with Apostolic Tradition, we hear the voice of Christ in the hear and now. It is contradictory, it is not a voice, that is confusing or is libertine, but rather asks us simply to leave all things behind and "follow." In following Christ, we have freedom from sin.
