“The feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, also celebrated as Our Lady of Victory or Victories, was established by Pope St. Pius V in 1571 to celebrate the miraculous victory of the Christian forces in the Battle of Lepanto on October 7th of that year. Previous to the decisive battle, St. Pius V had requested all Western Christians to pray the rosary; thus he attributed the victory to the power of the Marian prayer than the power of ships and cannons.



MEMORIAL OF POPE ST. JOHN XXIII

OCTOBER 11, 2022

Saint John XXIII, original named Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli, was born November 25, 1881, in Sotto il Monte, Italy and died June 3, 1963 in Rome. He was beatified September 3, 2000 and canonized April 27, 2014. His feast day is October 11. St. John XXIII was one of the most popular popes of all time (reigned 1958-63), who inaugurated a new era in the history of the Roman Catholic Church by his openness to change, shown especially in his convoking of the Second Vatican Council. He wrote several socially important encyclicals, most notably *Pacem in Terris*
