

Dear Friends in Christ,

September 14th is a day in the Church Calendar which traditionally changes our trajectory for the rest of the liturgical year. It is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross which celebrates the consecration of the church in Jerusalem that held a major portion of the cross discovered by St. Helen in around the year 326. It also is the day that the Western Monastic Fast begins and the day which also marked the quarterly Ember Days, fast days for the Church and for the sanctification of the clergy. While for many, September 14th came and went, the Feast in this mid-September provides with food for thought— The Word became Flesh in order to save us. Adam and Eve chose to eat the forbidden fruit of the tree of knowledge. Moses raised up the bronze serpent in the desert for all to see and be healed, a foreshadowing of the cross. When we see the Lord Jesus, the Son of Man, nailed to a tree, when we see Him raised up on the cross, it is by adoring the same Lord Jesus on the cross that we become healed. It is only through the cross that we have salvation. As St. Paul wrote, at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, those in heaven, those on earth, and those under the earth, and every tongue should confess to the glory of God the Father, Jesus Christ is LORD.
